Berlin – January 24, 2012

Berlin Buzzwords 2012 will take place on 4th and 5th June 2012 at Urania Berlin (<http://www.uraniaberlin.de>).

The 3rd edition of the conference for developers and users of open source projects, focuses on the issues of scalable search, data-analysis in the cloud and NoSQL-databases.

It is the conference goal to bring together developers, scientists, and analysts dealing with innovative technologies for storing, analysing and searching today's massive amounts of digital data.

The Call for Submission for Berlin Buzzwords 2012 is now open!

Presentations on scalable data processing mainly focusing on the following topics:

- IR / Search – Lucene, Solr, katta, ElasticSearch or comparable solutions
- NoSQL – like CouchDB, MongoDB, Jackrabbit, Hbase and others
- Large Data Processing – Hadoop itself, MapReduce, Cascading or Pig and relatives

can be handed in until **March 11th 2012**. Related topics are more than welcome. Presentations and talks should concentrate on the implementation of systems themselves, technical talks, real world applications and case studies. Berlin Buzzwords is looking for high quality, technical submissions ranging from principles to practice, with a background on the architecture of specific projects or deep dives into architectures built on top of e.g. Hadoop clusters.

The conference tickets are on sale now, starting from 350€ including free WLAN access, food, snacks and beverages throughout the 2 day conference. As well Berlin Buzzwords offers a special rate for groups of 5 and more attendees with a 15% discount off the regular ticket price.
